He entered Harvard College at nineteen years of age, took high rank in the required classical course of that period, was selected to deliver a Latin oration in his junior year, and graduated with distinction in the class of 1861. He continued in graduate work in the same university for over three years, receiving the degree of master of arts in 1864, studying at first in the engineering department of the Lawrence Scientific School and later in the college, where at the same time he was an assistant. From 1865 to 1869 he traveled and studied in Europe, his main work being in the Royal Mining Academy of Saxony, at...
