Moore as clerk, and adjourned to meet on the 1st of July, in the city of Baltimore, at the Maryland Penitentiary. Their duties, as pointed out in the resolution and order above referred to, consisted of an investigation of the following matters: 1st. The memorial of John H. Duvall and William Howard, asking relief from losses growing out of the destruction of their property by fire. 2d. The memorial of Charles Murdock, asking relief by a modification of bis contracts with the Directors of the Penitentiary and the equitable settlement of claims in dispute between them. 3d. An investigation of the manufacturing department of the Institution generally. 4th. An examination of the financial...
