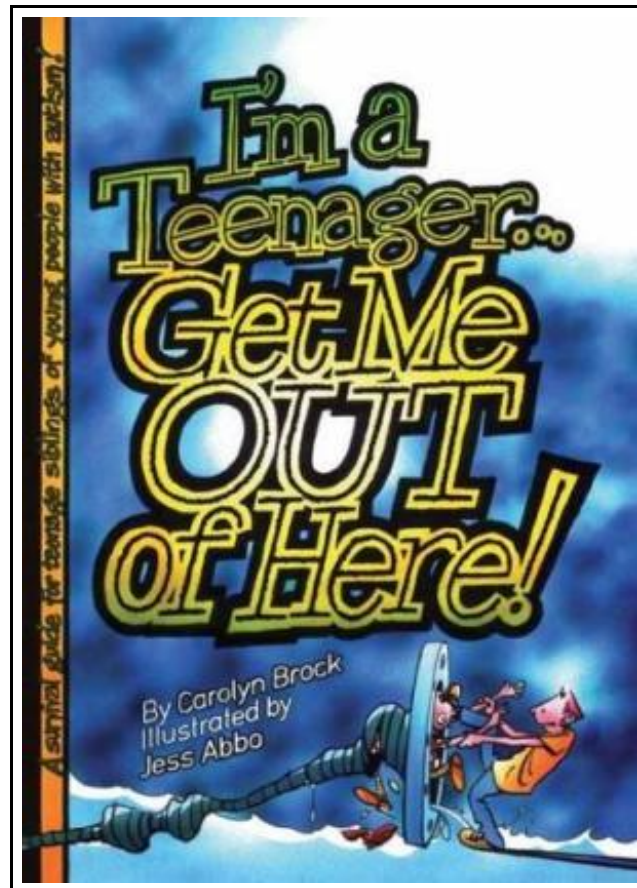

Talented illustrator, Jess Abbo, has given this book its unique, humorous, edgy and eye catching style.
